POSITION PURPOSE

The Full Time Seasonal Maintenance Team is a seasonal full time employment opportunity with Vintage Valley, LLC., supporting all aspects of the Vintage Valley Landscaping objectives, as well as urban and rural agriculture installation and maintenance. The candidate must be able to lead a crew without direct supervision and accomplish highly detailed landscape maintenance routines at client properties. The candidate must possess ability in landscape maintenance, landscape installations, horticulture and agriculture production. The candidate must be comfortable working outdoors in all temperatures and types of weather and must possess sufficient physical fitness/strength to lift landscaping tools and materials. The candidate must also be comfortable operating equipment such as commercial lawn mowers, tillers, backpack blowers, heavy equipment, and machines. Vintage Valley Team Leads should be friendly and dependable and be able to work with other staff as required, as well as have a strong attention to detail and ability to multitask. In all instances s/he must perform in accordance with and be committed to the Vintage Valley mission.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- 2. Execute work on residential and commercial contracts for Vintage Valley Landscaping, including landscape installations, landscape maintenance, and property maintenance and cleanups
- 3. Properly operate and maintain landscaping equipment and machines

- 6. Perform other duties to support success of Vintage Valley Landscaping

SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITY

Will supervise assigned crew members and work in conjunction with Installation Team Lead to accomplish all Vintage Valley Landscaping objectives.

ENVIRONMENT

The employee is required to kneel, squat, bend over and use hands to work in the gardens and in landscapes. The employee must be able to use motor skills and vision to operate landscape equipment. Candidate must be able to lift 75 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision and ability to adjust focus.

TRAVEL

Local travel to project sites is required. For normal working hours, transportation is provided via company vehicle.

- 6. Effective oral communication skills
- 7. Ability to execute scopes of work; adjust as situations warrant; think on feet
- 8. Ability to move through tasks in urgent manner and manage time effectively
- 9. Ability to adjust to emerging priorities, motivated, and effective listener
- 10. Must be willing to work flexible hours, including some split shifts
- 11. Ability to establish and maintain effective relationships with supervisory staff, other crew members, customers, and community residents
- 12. Ability to withstand wide range of weather conditions and lift and carry up to 75 lbs.
